## MINUTES OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE FOR THE EPISCOPAL DIOCESE OF ROCHESTER

OCTOBER 23, 2024

- 1. The September 2024 minutes were amended and approved.
- 2. Bishop Kara offered the Bishop Consult
  - a. The committee discussed ways for delegates to interact during lunch at convention.
    - i. During convention we will ask each delegate to sit with someone who is not from their parish and discuss 2 questions at lunch. Questions may include:
      - 1. A time that your parish received a grant and how they used this and how it enriched their parish community.
      - 2. What would you do were you to get a grant? What do you envision but don't have the resources to make happen.
    - ii. After lunch they will report out from their table something
    - iii. People will go to lunch in groups of 50.
    - iv. We hope to get a better feeling of how grants can be used.
  - b. Bishop Kara sent a survey related to clergy spouse support and another for retired clergy. The hope is to have a chaplain for retired clergy.
  - c. Richard mentioned the importance of staying connected with retired clergy.
  - d. The December 4<sup>th</sup> meeting will be at Bishop Kara's house at 145 Clover Hills Drive, Rochester, NY 14618. The time will be at 6 or 6:30.
- 3. The Standing Committee had interviews for Lydia Arnts and David Jutsum for Candidacy.
- 4. Lydia Arnts
  - i. Anti-racism training was discussed
    - 1. Intercultural competency is required at VTS involving discussions around identity and privilege and things that are often overlooked.
    - 2. She had discussions involving reparations and history of African Americans and First Nation Peoples in the USA.
    - 3. There was also work at St. Thomas when the diocese recommended the reading of *Unsettling Truths* at the parish.
  - ii. She was asked about finances/money, substance use, education, CPE, and relationships.
  - iii. Noted that the diocese should examine the level of support at the Strong Hospital CPE program for seminarians.
  - b. David Jutsum

- i. The standing committee asked what he has done to meet ordination requirements, specifically CPE.
- ii. He did complete CPE in a hospital.
- iii. He did anti-racism training through the diocese.
- iv. He completed a placement at St. Lukes in Brockport with Rev. Elizabeth Hardin.
- v. Liz will write a letter to say that we met with David.
- 5. The following recommendations were made for the two interviewees:
  - a. The group voted to endorse the recommendation of the COM FOR Lydia Arnts.
  - b. The group voted to endorse the recommendation of the COM for David Jutsum.
- 6. Columba closed the meeting in prayer.
- 7. The motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Roxanne and was seconded by Columba. All were in favor and the meeting was adjourned.
